

# Productive Practices Straddle Stool

a picture guide



## SEAT HEIGHT



Control the height of the stool by pulling the front lever forward. To lift the seat up, you must remove your weight from the stool. To lower the height you may remain seated and pull the lever as shown.

## SEAT TILT



To adjust the tilt of the seat, lift up on the rear adjustment knob. By lifting the lever, the seat will move with the operator. When the lever is returned to its resting-lower position, the seat will lock in that position.



### To Fasten Armrest...

- 1) attach the t-bar with the locking-handle supplied...
- 2) adjust and tighten the height-control knob while...
- 3) assuring that a half inch space exists between the end of the armrest and the seat.

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Turn the tension adjustment clockwise (to the right as you are looking at it) to increase the vertical tension of the armrest.

Turn the tension adjustment counter-clockwise (to the left as you are looking at it) to decrease the vertical tension of the armrest.

You will need to turn a few times to feel any measurable change in the tension.

You should attempt to find the tension which will allow your arm to levitate.

## A S S I S T A N T   A R M



If you have purchased an Assistant Arm for your stool, the attachment 'J-bar' will arrive installed. Simply align the slot in the ratchet under the armrest with the height adjustment knob and slide in. Tighten knob at the appropriate height.

# R A T C H E T   A D J U S T M E N T



Move the adjustment lever in the direction you wish to adjust the armrest. Move it out to open the armrest and move it in to close the armrest. You will need to remove your weight from the armrest to adjust.
